Background

- Presentation focuses on dissemination of SITS within the context of the Statistical Yearbook being compiled on annual basis by the SADC Secretariat
- SYB serves as a vehicle for the dissemination of data on a wide range of indicators, including Trade in Services
- Development of SYB started 2 years ago
 - 1st edition is available on the SADC website
 - 2nd edition will be finalised within the 1st quarter of 2014

Overview of SITS tables

- SITS tables in the Yearbook include:
 - Values of Exports and Imports of services
 - Values of Exports and Imports of Transportation services
 - Values of Exports and Imports of Travel Services
 - Values of Exports and Imports of Other Services

Data Sources

- Data in the yearbook was obtained from 3 main sources:
 - SADC Member States
 - Secretariat of the Committee of Central Bank Governors
 - International Sources such as the IMF, the World Bank, etc

Process followed

- Secretariat populates the tables using available data, mainly from Member States
- Populated tables are sent to Member States for their review of data and they make revisions to the figures as appropriate
- Populated tables are sent back to the Secretariat
- A validation workshop is held to review the figures together with representatives from the National Statistical Offices

Any Data Gaps

- Taking into account reasons why SADC needs SITS, it can be argued that the data currently available at the Secretariat is not adequate:
 - Data not disaggregated by key sectors identified by SADC
 - Data not disaggregated by modes of supply
 - Data not disaggregated by major trading partners

Way Forward

- Need for mechanisms to ensure that more detailed data on trade in services is available at the SADC Secretariat.
- Need to decide on the following:
 - Template outlining minimum set of data elements to be collected
 - How often data needs to be submitted to the Secretariat
 - Guidance on how revisions will be managed
 - How the data will be disseminated
