It hasbeensuggestedby a number ofdelegations thatit mightbehelpful to producea briefandsimple noteon assumptions applicable totheschedulingof commitmentsin basic telecoms. The purpose of the attached note is to assist delegations in ensuring the transparency of their commitments and to promote a better understanding of the meaning of commitments. This note is not intended to have or acquire any binding legal status.

NOTESFOR SCHEDULING BASICTELECOMSERVICESCOMMITMENTS

- 1.1. Unlessotherwisenotedinthesector column, any basic telecomservicelistedinthe sector column:
 - a) encompasseslocal,longdistanceandinternationalservices forpublicand non-public use:
 - b) may be provided on a facilities-basis or by resale; and
 - c) (may be provided through any means of technology (e.g., cable12, wireless, satellites).
- 1.2. Subsector(g)--privateleasedcircuitservices --involvestheabilityofservicesuppliers tosellorleaseany typeofnetworkcapacity forthesupply ofserviceslistedin any other basictelecomservicesubsectorunlessotherwisenotedinthesectorcolumn. This would include capacity via cable, satellite and wireless network.
- 1.3. Inview ofpoints1 and2above,itshould notbenecessary tolistcellularormobile services asaseparate subsector.However,anumber ofMembers havedoneso, anda numberofoffershavecommitmentsonlyinthesesubsectors.Therefore,inordertoavoid extensivechangesinschedules,itwouldseem appropriate forMemberstomaintain separateentriesfor thesesubsectors.

CHAIRMAN'S NOTE

Market AccessLimitations onSpectrum Availability

ManyMembers haveentriesinthemarketaccesscolumnoftheir schedulesindicating "subjecttoavailabilityofspectrum/frequency"orsimilarwording. thatcommitmentsare Inlight ofthephysicalnature ofspectrumandtheconstraints inherent inits use, it is understandable thatMembersmay havesoughttorely onthesewordstoadequately protectlegitimatespectrummanagement policies. Thereis, however.doubtthatwords suchas "subjecttoavailability ofspectrum/frequency"aslistedin the market access columnofmanyMembers'schedules achieve thatobjective.

Spectrum/frequencymanagementisnot,per se,a measurewhichneedstobelisted underArticleXVI.Furthermore,undertheGATSeachMember hastherighttoexercise spectrum/frequency management,whichmay affectthenumberofservicesuppliers, providedthatthisis donein accordancewithArticleVI and other relevantprovisionsof theGATS. Thisincludestheabilitytoallocate frequencybandstakingintoaccount existingandfutureneeds.Also,Memberswhichhavemadeadditionalcommitmentinline with theReferencePaper onregulatoryprinciples areboundbyitsparagraph 6.

Therefore, words such as "subject to availability of spectrum/frequency" are unnecessary and should be deleted from Members's chedule
